

## Sophia Zoumbaki



Sophia Zoumbaki is a Research Director at the Institute of Historical Studies (IHR), Section of Greek and Roman Antiquity (KERA), of the National Hellenic Research Foundation (NHRF).

She studied at the Department of History and Archaeology of the Philosophical Faculty of the University of Athens (1983-1988). Thanks to a scholarship of the Austrian Ministry of Education, Sciences and Culture, she pursued her postgraduate studies at the Institute of Ancient History and Epigraphy of the University of Vienna, where she obtained her M.Phil. (1992) and her Ph.D. (1995).

She has taken part in several Greek and international campaigns of field archaeology, both excavations and archaeological surface surveys (Ceos, Messene, Butrint, Oiniadai) and also worked as a volunteer at the Sculpture Collection of the National Archaeological Museum in Athens.

She has carried out several National and European Research Programs, both as a coordinator and as a participant, such as FP7-PEOPLE-2012-IEF (Funding Scheme: MARIE CURIE Actions –Intra-European Fellowships), interstate program PLATON, ARISTEIA I and II, THALES etc.

Her research interest include epigraphy; prosopography and onomastics; society and economy of the polis in the Hellenistic and Roman period; civic institutions and relations of the Greek world with Rome; Roman and Italian entrepreneurs in the East.

She has published over 50 articles in academic journals, conference proceedings and collective volumes and has organised conferences on topics concerning Roman history and archaeology.
