The Institute of Historical Research of the National Hellenic Research Foundation is pleased to announce the organisation of the fourth consecutive Summer School on Ancient Greek and Roman Numismatics, to take place at its premises in Athens, from 1st to 10 of July 2020.

The Summer School is addressed to undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD students in History, Archaeology and Art History, to historians and archaeologists, but also to individuals with a special interest in numismatics. It offers a series of courses on numismatics, history, methodology and various special themes and consists of lectures, practical sessions and visits to numismatic collections, museums and relevant archaeological sites in Attica.

The lecturers are researchers at the Institute of Historical Research of the National Hellenic Research Foundation, framed by other experts in numismatics. Each year a visiting scholar is invited to develop a special topic. Our visiting scholar for 2020 will be Thomas Faucher, Researcher, IRAMAT-CRP2A (CNRS / Univ. Bordeaux Montaigne).

The courses will be taught in English and will be offered to a limited number of applicants who will be selected by the Scientific Committee.

All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
