About the Workshop

The “Proteins in the World of Synthetic Polymers” workshop will be held from the 19th to the 20th of March, 2015 at the premises of the National Hellenic Research Foundation, 48 Vassileos Constantinou Ave., Athens, Greece.

The workshop will bring together researchers working in the field of synthetic polymers and proteins. The recent advances and envisioned future developments in the design, synthesis and characterization, as well as applications, of hybrid nanosystems composed of synthetic polymers and proteins will be discussed. We do hope that we will create a scientific atmosphere that will encourage the exchange of ideas.

The workshop is sponsored by the NANOMACRO 1129 project (<http://nanomacro.gr/>), which is implemented in the framework of the Operational Program “Education and Life-long Learning” (Action “ARISTEIA I”) and it is co-funded by the European Union (European Social Fund) and by national funds.

1. Language: English (in Word Format).
2. Font type "Times New Roman", font size 12 and single line spacing. Title should be in bold. Please include author names and affiliations in italics. Presenting author's name should be underlined and email address should be included. References and figures can be also included in the abstract.
3. Abstracts must not exceed one A4 page.

Deadline for abstract submission is 15th February, 2015.
